Plugs/electrical sockets



As already mentioned, your plugs might not fit to our sockets (applies even to German ones!). This picture shows you how our electric installations look. You are fully responsible that your laptop/equipment fits to our installations! To be on the safe side, we suggest that you bring a world-wide adapter with you. We will not provide them for you.

Public transportation in Zurich

All participants (except those living in Zurich permanently) will get a multiple day pass, valid for 6 x 24 hours in fare zone 110 (covers Youth Hostel – University and most of the city center). The card will be given to you on 28 January. During a 24-hour period, you have unlimited rides by tram/bus/ship. As an attachment, I'm sending you detailed instruction regarding the ticket to buy at the airport, transfer airport –main station – Youth Hostel –University and – important – how to validate the multiple day pass. Most probably, the multiple day pass will not cover the whole conference. Please buy the remaining single tickets on your own.
