## Information about public transportation

## Transfer Airport - Youth Hostel/Hotel - Conference Venue

We recommend that you buy a public transportation ticket not only for the transfer, but valid for 24 hours in Zurich (fare area 10). At the airport, there are touch-screen ticket machines that accept Swiss money and credit cards.
To get the correct ticket, proceed as follows:

- Point of Departure: Zürich Flughafen / Airport
- Point of Destination Zürich City alle Ziele / Zone 10
- 24 hour ticket / $2^{\text {nd }}$ Class / Adult

Procedure at ticket machine to
travelfrom the airport to Zurich by train

With this ticket, you can not only travel from the airport to the youth hostel/hotel, but for 24 hours in fare zone 10, which includes the Youth Hostel and the University. It is valid for train and tram and bus equally.

At Zurich Main Station, proceed to "Bahnhofstrasse" and take tram no. 7 to station "Morgental" (direction: Wollishofen) to get to the Youth Hostel.

## How to find us

For travelling from the Youth Hostel to the conference venue, take tram no. 7 at station "Morgental", change at "Bahnhof Enge" to tram no. 5. Leave the tram at station "Platte".

Public transportation during ZICE13
We will give you a multiple day pass, valid for $6 \times 24$ hours in fare-zone 10 (covers Zurich downtown, with Youth Hostel and University)
The ticket will be handed out on Saturday afternoon.

## Important:

Validate the first 24 -hour slot only when the ticket you bought at the airport has expired. If you manage your $6 \times 24$ hours carefully, the multiple day pass should serve you until the end of the workshop. Then, you'd only have to buy a ticket to bring you to the airport.

To start the first 24 -hour-period, insert the ticket in the slot at the ticket machine. It will then get an imprint, showing date and time of validation. For the next 24 hours, just insert the same ticket again for the second stamp, and so on . . . .
During those $\mathbf{2 4}$ hours, you have unlimited rides per tram/bus/ship in fare area 10.
